Notice is hereby given that the Fall Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, August 13, 2024, in the Town of Waubeek of Pepin County, will vote at County Board Room, Pepin County Government Center (740 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. W. Durand, WI 54736). Electors may vote for candidates in only ONE political party (Democratic, Republican, Libertarian, Constitution), Statewide, Congressional, Legislative, and County races are on ballot (all vote for one). Sample ballots are posted at the board at Northside Auto and Polzer Brothers) and are available online at MyVote.wi.gov. The polls will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. *An acceptable PROOF OF RESIDENCY document is required to register to vote. An acceptable PHOTO ID is required to receive a ballot.
