Notice is hereby given that the Fall Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, August 11, 2026, in the Town of Waubeek of Pepin County, will vote at Pepin County Government Center - County Board Room (740 7th Ave W Durand, WI). Electors may vote for candidates in only ONE political party (democratic, Republican, Libertarian, Constitution), Statewide, Congressional, Legislative, and County races are on ballot (all vote for one). Sample ballots are posted at the Town Hall and are available online at MyVote.wi.gov The polls will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 8 p.m. *An acceptable PROOF OF RESIDENCY document is required to register to vote. An acceptable PHOTO ID is required to receive a ballot. For further information, visit www.bringit.wi.gov and www.elections.wi.gov.* Our polling place is accessible to elderly and disabled voters.
